Arrival & Dismissal - Grades 1-5

- Arrival Time 8:25-8:35 am
- Do not arrive before 8:25 am
- Line up by homerooms
- Late bell 8:35 am
- Dismissal Time 3:30-3:40 pm
- Playground **CLOSED**
- **GO ZONE** for car riders only



Arrival & Dismissal - Kindergarten

- Arrival Times
 - K (AM) 8:25-8:35 am Door C13
 - K (PM) 12:40-12:45 pm Door A1
 - Line up by homerooms
 - Late bell 8:35 am & 12:45 pm
- Dismissal Times
 - K (AM) 11:20 am Door A1
 - K (PM) 3:30 pm Door C13

- 4 feet of separation
- Ultraboards

Lunch Protocols

- 30 minutes per grade level
- 6 feet of separation between all seating options
- Wash/sanitize hands **before** and **after**
- Seating at tables in cafeteria and ground floor hallway
- Ultraboards in use
- Students **MUST** sit at assigned classroom tables





Lunch Protocols

- School or home no shops
- No student microwave access
- Masks <u>required</u> except when eating
- Mask up when requesting help
- Students may bring book to read if they choose



Lunch Protocols

- Grab and Go meal service
 - Order daily in homeroom
 - Hot, deli, salad and bagel bag options daily
 - Pick up in cafeteria for students
 - For CLA students and families
 - Buzz at Door C15 for service
- Packed lunch items make it easy for students



Recess Protocols - Outdoor

- 30 minutes lunchtime recess Grades 1-5
- May use play structures
- Equipment for each homeroom
- Designated play spaces for each homeroom
- Classroom recess (K-3)
 - o 15 minutes
 - Will implement a schedule for all homerooms to follow



Recess Protocols - Indoor

- 30 minutes lunchtime recess Grades 1-5
- In each homeroom classroom
- Equipment for each homeroom
- Students may choose to read or bring appropriate items to use
- Classroom recess (K-3)
 - o 15 minutes
 - Will implement a schedule for all homerooms to follow



Schedule and Encores

- Resuming typical encore offerings
- All encores to be held in typical encore locations
- All learning support, reading support, math support and related services will be in person
- Students travel to encore and support spaces
- Grades 4 & 5 will switch for departmentalized classes



Health Office Protocols

- Parents often ask when they should keep their student home from school. If your student does not feel well, please keep them home.
 Specific symptoms to pay attention for include:
 - Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea

Sanitation Protocols

- Wash/sanitize hands <u>frequently</u>
- Masks <u>required</u> at all times (except when drinking or eating lunch)
- Limiting students in restroom at same time
- Physical distancing marked in restrooms
- Ultraboards available in ALL instructional spaces
- Lunch and recess in classroom cohorts



Sanitation Protocols

- Classroom recess equipment
- Hallway and stairwell directional stickers
- Students not being released from school to shops
- Alcohol wipes available in ALL spaces
- Hand sanitizer dispensers at all entrance/exit points
- Minimize student sharing of school supplies
- Water bottle filling stations on each floor
